Clumping bamboo, maximum Height: 12-15 feet, diameter stalk 0.75 inches

Arrow Bamboo (Fargesia nitida)





Growing up to 5 m (16 ft) tall by 3 m (10 ft) broad, it forms clumps of slender arching canes which turn black after two or three seasons. The abundant lance-shaped leaves are 4–13 cm (2–5 in) long.

Black Bamboo (Phyllostachys nigra)



Compressed internodes with tortoiseshell-like appearance. This internodal compression result in shorter heights (25' +/-) and thicker cane diameters (relative to height) than many other Phyllostachys species.
