### SITUATION

<b>Current Situation:</b>	Damage Inspection Teams have completed damage inspections for the Sulphur Incident and are continuing to survey for damaged and destroyed structures throughout the Redwood Fire. Firefighters utilized favorable weather conditions to their advantage today, across both fires, towards achieving containment and providing structure defense, however, the fire continues to burn in multiple directions threatening numerous communities and infrastructure. Steep inaccessible terrain coupled with critical fuel moistures, and northwest winds will provide challenges for crews working on the fire. <b>34,000 acres have burned in the Redwood Fire, 10% contained. 2,500 acres have burned in the Sulphur Fire, 55% contained.</b> There have been 8 fatalities and approximately 8000 people have evacuated throughout the incident. We ask the public to exercise caution and remember to be prepared to evacuate when asked. <p><b>Evacuation Orders (Continued):</b></p>	<p>Bank Rd. from Highway 20 to 17<sup>th</sup> Street; Lakeshore Dr. west of Country Club Dr; San Joaquin Ave. west of Arrowhead Ave. All areas of west of Clearlake Park including the Elem Indian Colony remain under evacuation order</p> <p>REDWOOD FIRE: West Rd from State St north; East Road north of School Way; Laughlin Rd north of State St and all roads feeding in; East Rd south to Hwy 20; east of East Rd around Hwy 20 to Horseshoe Circle; Reeves Canyon Rd; Golden Rule Park; Pine Mountain subdivision; Ridgewood Rd leading into the Pine Mountain subdivision from Eastside Rd to the south to Bear Canyon Rd. Bear Canyon Rd to Tomki Rd. All feeder roads to the north and south of Ridgewood Rd (Pine Mountain subdivision) and Bear Canyon Road; Canyon Rd to Eastside Rd south to Pine Mountain Rd; Van Arsdale area north of Eel River; Cave Creek subdivision including scenic Appaloosa and including all feeder roads; Van Arsdale road south of the Eel River; North of Gibson Ln from Old Wagon Rd to Eel River Rd, continuing in an easterly direction to but not including Mid Mountain Rd. From this point at Mid Mountain Rd north to Elk Mountain Rd at the Lake County Line. ALL roads in the community of Potter Valley feeding onto Potter Valley Road south to Highway 20 and east to the Lake County line. Evacuees from this area should head south to Highway 20. People leaving from Lake County and the Lake Pillsbury side should travel southeast on Elk Mountain Rd to Upper Lake.</p>
